PLEASE BE ADVISED THAT Pursuant to Schedule A of Bylaw No. 510-95 – 2013, DOG LICENSES ARE REQUIRED FOR YOUR DOGS and are available at the Village Office for the low fee of \$20.00 each pet.

Fines for not picking up after your pet can be up to \$250.00 – so please pick up after your pet. PLEASE KEEP YOUR PET ON A LEASH.

**PLEASE BE ADVISED** the cardboard recycling bin has been moved to the AgriPlex parking lot. Your telephone books can now be taken to the cardboard recycling bin. Your cardboard cannot be picked up with household garbage. Newsprint, glossy paper and catalogues may be left in the bins west of the Village Office. Eyeglasses and cell phones may be left at the Village Office.
