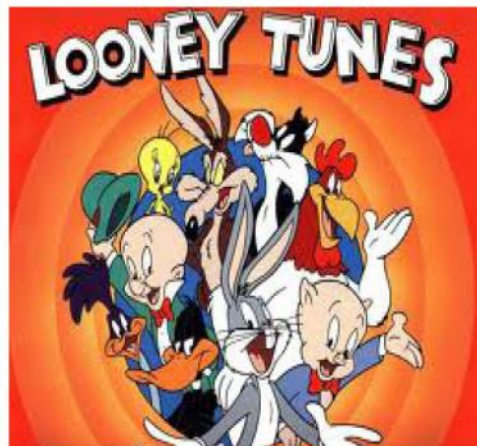

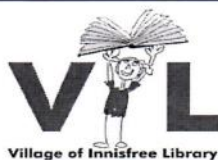

THE FILM

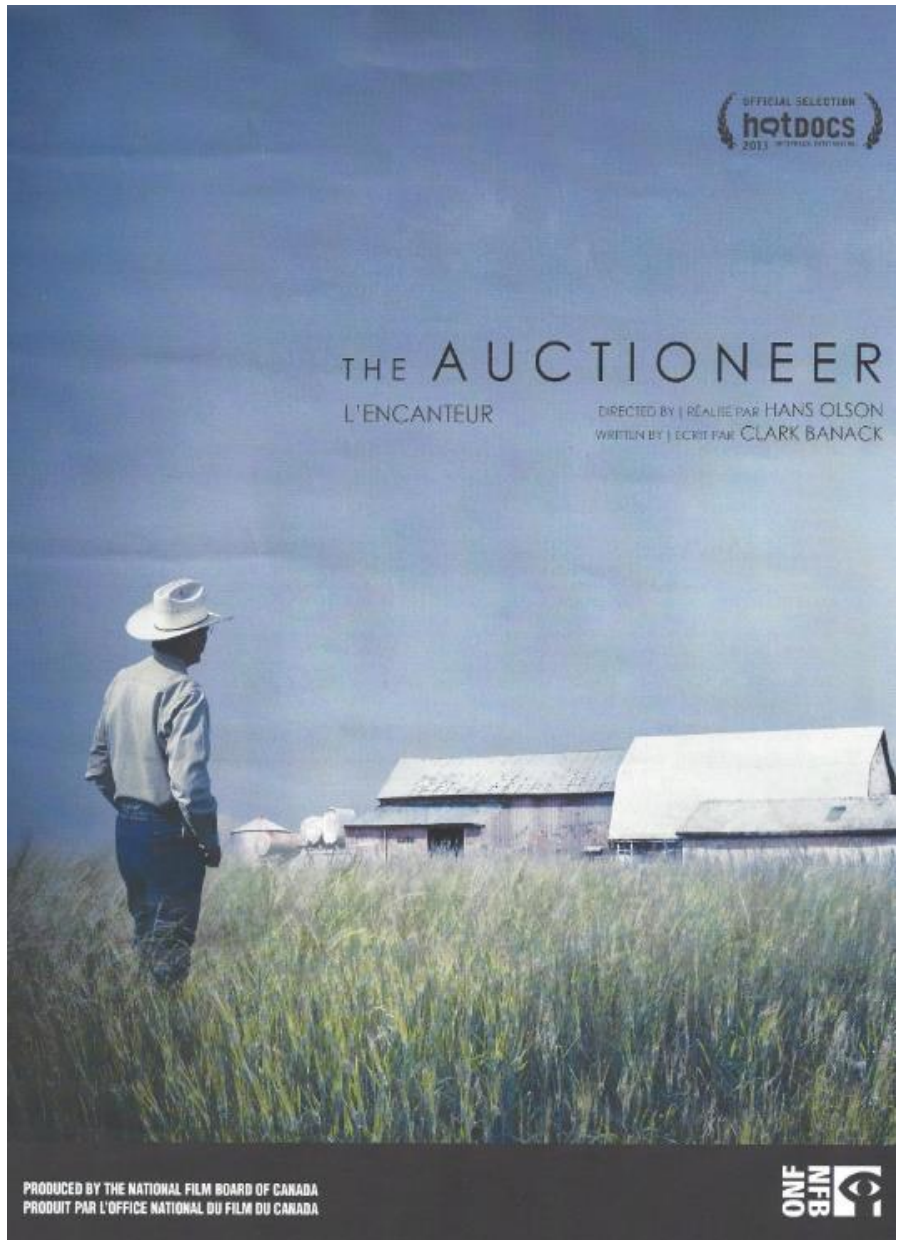
Dale Menzak is an auctioneer specializing in the sale of family farms. A man of few words when not auctioneering, he also works part-time as an undertaker. From his portable auctioneer's booth, Dale helps to liquidate antiquated farm equipment, after which he dons a sombre necktie and returns to his job at the funeral home. Set against a backdrop of gorgeous Prairie vistas, *The Auctioneer* observes Dale from a respectful distance as he facilitates the difficult process of letting go.

HANS OLSON, DIRECTOR

Hans Olson grew up in Armeria, Alberta, and is now based in Edmonton. After completing workshops at the Film and Video Arts Society of Alberta, he studied screenwriting at Langara College in Vancouver. He has directed two narrative shorts set in the Canadian Prairies, *Bronwen's Ark* (2006) and *Baby Boots* (2008), and a short documentary, *Where Credit is Due*, shot in Guatemala in 2008. In 2009, Olson was selected as one of five emerging filmmakers to participate in the Directors' Lab at the Canadian Film Centre (CFC) in Toronto. His most recent short film, *Champagne*, was produced by the CFC, screened at the 2010 Toronto International Film Festival and has been broadcast on CBC and TMN.

CLARK BANACK, WRITER

Clark Banack holds a Ph.D. from the University of British Columbia and currently teaches in the Department of Political Science at York University in Toronto. He grew up on a farm in rural Alberta and pursued a career in academia after his family discontinued farming and held their own auction sale in 2001. His background, along with his academic interest in rural-urban issues and "agrarian identity" in the Canadian Prairies, certainly helped to shape *The Auctioneer*.
