### **Innisfree Cemetery Committee Update**

Updating the cemetery records is proceeding well. Trudy Shukalak and Dave Marynowich at the County of Minburn office have been very helpful and we now have a clear idea of those areas of responsibility that are the village's and the Cemetery Committee's , and those that are the County's. Plans are underway to publish a set of Cemetery Regulations by the summer's end, and to move copies of our records and maps to an electronic format to ensure we have backup copies of all our paper records. The 1954 map doesn't conform to the current cemetery layout, so a request will be made to the County to survey the grounds in order to give us an updated map.

If you've been at, or driven past, the cemetery lately, no doubt you noticed how nice the grounds look. Jennifer Johnson and helper Vi Mitchell have been given the job of mowing and weed whipping the grounds. We've been pruning a few of the overgrown maples and spruces to allow easier access for the mowers as well

A huge thank you goes out to the kind and generous organizations and people who sent donations to the Cemetery Fund this month. As well, the County's yearly contribution of \$500 toward the operation and maintenance of the cemetery has been received. It was especially nice to see Harry Hlus drive out to the cemetery this month. Harry kept the records and grounds for many years and still takes an interest in seeing that the grounds are maintained even though he no longer resides in the village. If you wish to make a donation to the Cemetery Fund, please see Jennifer Hodel at the Village Office or Sheila Whitmore.

The Cemetery Committee will be recommending a new fee structure to Village Council this fall. For many years now, plots at the Innisfree Cemetery have been priced at \$130 each, but that price needs to be adjusted to reflect the rising costs of maintenance and improvements. If you have any comments or suggestions to make, please call.

The next meeting of the Cemetery Committee will be July 30, 7:00 pm at the Village Office and as always, our meetings are open to anyone who wishes to attend.
