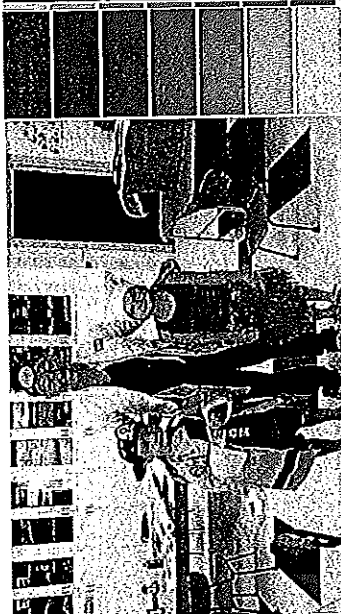
Things kids should bring:

If you or your child have any suggestions feel free to give us a call at the number provided on the back of the brochure.

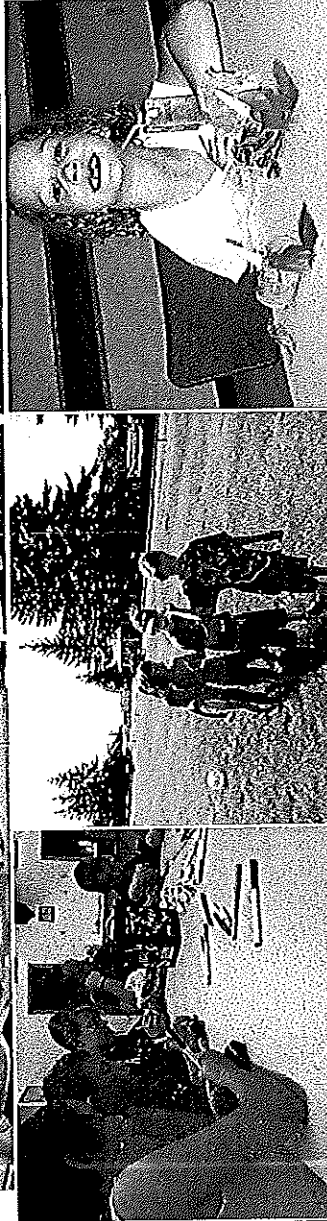
Activities


